About the artwork

This piece captures the destruction and fragmentation caused by conflict, using black cardboard collage to represent shattered buildings. The cardboard is cracked into four pieces, symbolizing the breakdown of structures, both physical and emotional, in times of war. The background is drenched in a gradient of red, diluted from top to bottom, evoking a sense of violence, chaos, and the overwhelming weight of loss. As the red fades, the acrylic paint decomposes into tired, pockmarked dots—reminiscent of pimples—emphasizing the marks left by conflict. These imperfect, worn textures speak to the toll of destruction, not only on buildings but on the human spirit, reflecting the scars left behind by trauma and grief. The work explores the physical and psychological decay that follows war, offering a visceral reminder of how deeply conflict alters everything it touches—bodies, buildings, and souls alike.
