About the artwork

"Al Safa and Al Marwa" (2026) is a powerful conceptual drawing that cross references the ritualistic, repetitive struggle of sacred pacing with the grueling daily labor of women at the Ceuta border crossing. Executed in graphite and pen, the work portrays the heavy bundles traditionally loaded with used clothing not merely as commercial cargo, but as a dense, living archive of human movement, memory, and exhaustion.

Through a striking visual juxtaposition of filled forms and stark outlines, the artwork strips the subjects of individual identity to amplify their collective history. The body becomes an extension of the material it bears, capturing the physical weight of borders, social shifts, and political divisions. Ultimately, the piece honors the quiet gestures of female labor and resistance, rendering the invisible struggles of these carrying bodies into an undeniable historical testament.
